The UG Programmes B.Com Co-operation, BBA, BCA and PG courses MA English and M.Com were launched from the academic year 2013 – 14 and the BSW programme commenced from the academic year 2015-16. Three other Programmes M.Sc Mathematics, B.Com Finance and B.Sc Psychology commenced from the academic year 2017-18. M.Sc Counseling Psychology Programmes is commenced from the academic year 2020-21.

The college is located at Angadikadavu near Iritty in Kannur District. It is managed by the Salesian Priests of Don Bosco, an International Religious Congregation of the Catholic Church, having over 3,000 educational institutions in 132 countries.
