The country ranks 132 out of 191 countries considered for the human development index (HDI) of United Nations Development Programme in 2022(UNDP 2022). The UN has emphasized much on health promotion though the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs No. 3) as good health and well being of All by 2030. Moreover, different states have different levels of socio-demographic and public health achievements. It is also observed considerable inequities in health status and access to healthcare services in the country. So the role of social worker in public health and its emerging trends is inevitable.

There has been a drastic change in the food habits of people due to various reasons including availability, economy, taste and even human laziness. b. Details of the presenting author has to be specifically mentioned

MAIN PAPER SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING DETAILS

1. The main paper should not exceed a maximum of 4000 words.

2. The document should be in M.S Word document format. 3. The paper should include the Title, Author (s) name; Author's profile, References in APA style, mailing address, contact number, e-mail ID.

a. If there are co-authors for the paper to be presented, it has to be mentioned in the order of sequence

4. Font Size 12 for main text and 14 for titles, Times New Roman font with one and half space.
