05.	Infrastructure and Facilities	Time to time maintenance activities are carried out in the institution. Free WiFi is available to the students.
		The solar power system is fully operational. Bund is constructed in the stream flowing behind the College to



		conserve water. Napkin vending machines and incinerators are installed in ladies toilet for the convenience.
06.	Administrative and Financial Management	Admission of students to the college is through single window system of the Kannur University. As the college is a self Finance institute, fifty percent of admission is done through management quota. During admission procedure, all government norms regarding reservation is followed. The major source of income for the college is through the fee collected from the students. In the beginning of the academic year, detailed budget is prepared by the administrator of the college and the same will be followed. The Financial Audit is carried out by M. Thomas & Co, Chartered Accountants, Kochi. Institution participates in AISHE survey, NIRF. Institute is ISO Certified. The institute is approved by AICTE and extension of approval is done every year.
07.	Community Engagement and social Responsibility	Don Bosco Arts & Science College is committed for the holistic development of the students. College is constructing a SNEHAVEEDU (Home for Homeless) every year. The house is constructed by the support of students, parents, management, alumni and other collaborators. Departments organize Snehabhavan visits as part of extension Activities. 6 Students from riot hit Manipur are studying in the college for free of cost.

Challenges and threats:

Admission is the main challenge faced by the institute. The students who seek admission in science subjects are very low comparing to arts subjects. Large number of students is going abroad for their higher studies.

Number of seats is vacant in nearby Govt. and Govt. aided colleges also. The scholarships for SC/ST students are not distributed to the students who prefer Self Financial Colleges.

As the college is Self Financial, no government fund is available for any development/research etc.

Perspective Plan:

As the number of students getting admitted into BSc Mathematics and MSc Mathematics reduced, college disaffiliated these programmes.

College is started with new-generation programme BSc Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning in the academic year 2023-2024. And also, HEI is planning to introduce Programmes like BSc Cyber Security and BSc Data Analytics in the coming years.

HEI introduced scholarships for the students who join with high marks. Scholarships are given to the students who secure A and A+ grades.

Active participation in University Arts & Sports also attracted the students. Don Bosco Arts & Science College stood 4th or 5th in the university Arts Fest in the last years far ahead of number of Govt. and Aided colleges.

Personal care is given to each and every student of the college. Two experienced full time mentors are always available in campus.

Parents are given active rolls in academic and extracurricular activities.

Don Bosco Arts & Science College is the only campus in Kannur University with State-of-the art Air conditioned Theatre-cum-Auditorium.



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
